

- Delving into the wealth of expertise available across the member organizations but also through its unrivalled network of focal points at country and regional levels, the P4H Network is backed by a diversity of expertise helping delineate these objectives in clear-cut priority areas.
- P4H acts as an adviser to decision makers, ensuring that they can reach the right decision the first time, documenting their policy options. In addition, P4H strives for better operational results through co-ordination at country level or at regional level. Complementarities, synergies and collaboration principles underpin its methodological design of joint support in the field of health financing and social health protection.

• Increasingly, P4H acts as a global hub and insight broker, not only in technical matters but also to provide benchmarking and mentoring in the setting-up of networks; effective co-operation mechanisms; document health financing and social protection in a broad term; and provide insight to global policy leaders.

Effective work pathway: where do we go from here


- Reflecting on the three functions: change agent / market place / knowledge broker, P4H will accelerate its organic growth across the three roles, as well as keep a focus on business development leads (Network expansion and technical remit depth increase).
- A transformative network, P4H will in 2017 increments its resource commitment to facilitating a strategic and operational shift towards peer networking and expert exchange. This entails primarily the strengthening of the Knowledge Management process designed and enshrined in the web platform / digitization dynamics. This in turn will enable member organizations and Network partners better grasp of the breadth and depth of activities across the Network's geographical and technical span.

• In other words, the Network expansion will impact the number and variety of partners, bolstered by:

Product 1: the development of Leadership capabilities (L4UHC delineated across regions and sectors) primarily aiming at leaders committed to progressing towards UHC

Product 2: the strengthening of KM process within the broader frame of the new web platform, encompassing the entire range of P4H knowledge, insights, products and services

Product 3: the modelisation of country collaboration mechanisms through kits and operational guidance



Products 4 & 5: the establishment of two regional networks focusing on health financing for UHC and social health protection in Africa and in Asia-Pacific

Product 6: the mapping of unprecedented insight for action in the field of: political economy studies.

- The expansion of the P4H Network to new members (starting with Morocco, testing Tunisia, GCC countries, EU institutions, Regional institutions) will underpin this growth strategy for 2017, as per the express mandate conferred by the P4H Steering Group.
- In sum, P4H will manage a continuous improvement of its operations and processes, while ensuring value pathways are created through innovative products (tailored and off the shelf) rolled out according to geographical context.

P4H a role model?

- Based on recent analytical trends, the following activities will be emphasised upon
 - Support to collaborative network development with Network setup kits and presentations (across international organizations, starting with existing requests within WHO)
 - Support to achieve digital transformation through command of digitalized work processes and offering of web platform white labelling (most global networks expressed an interest to sign off with the P4H Web platform)
 - Support WHO and in particular the HGF Department with effective communications process so as to optimize collaboration opportunities (strategic and functional comms action plan)
- On an operational level, and under the management of the P4H Network Co-ordinator, a timeline and schedule of work will help map the deliverables expected from the Co-ordination Desk staff as well as inputs from the country and regional focal points (see Appendix).


