






### **Context: Moving towards Universal Health Coverage**



Technical versus adaptive issues	P4H Social Metalin Metalin Metalin
Technical Problems	Adaptive Challenges
1. Easy to identify	1. Difficult to identify (easy to deny)
2. Often lend themselves to quick and easy (cut- and-dried) solutions	<ol> <li>Require changes in values, beliefs, roles, relationships, &amp; approaches to work. Implies learning.</li> </ol>
3. Often can be solved by an authority or expert	3. People with the problem do the work of solving it
Require change in just one or a few places; often contained within organizational boundaries	Require change in numerous places; usually cross organizational boundaries
5. People are generally receptive to technical solutions	5. People often resist even acknowledging adaptive challenges
Solutions can often be implemented quickly – even by edict	6. "Solutions" require experiments and new discoveries; they can take a long time to implement and cannot be implemented by edict

## **CN: Purpose and Objectives**



Purpose of analysis: to support the GOM in **making decisions on health reforms**, particularly on health financing, by reviewing existing evidence.

This will include the **potential role** of health insurance, earmarked tax financing, user fees, institutional re-organization, and efficiency potentials.

The specific objectives are:


- Advocacy and joint support to the government in engaging in an inclusive and consultative process;
- Assessing the financial and technical feasibility of the various health reforms currently under discussion. Includes: a review of how each reform option will contribute to health financing, systems strengthening (including decentralization), social protection, and national development goals;
- Provide guidance on how best to implement each reform option; and
- Assistance in the development of an implementation plan, and strengthening implementation capacity.


#### **WHY P4H?**




Some challenges of development cooperation...

- Incoherence among and within development partners (DPs)
- Support provided frequently fails to recognize the complexity of the issues
  - DPs providing conflicting messages, or following different approaches and agendas about equitable and efficient health financing
  - Resulting in often separate and uncoordinated work streams
- →Know what others are doing
- →Identify areas for collaboration and synergies
- →Peer pressure for unbiased support
