Overview

The Leadership for Universal Health Coverage Program supports countries in advancing and accelerating their UHC agenda by supporting the country counterparts (as individuals and as country teams) with leadership training, coalition building support and results-oriented collective action initiatives. The Program’s main focus rests on “how to” tackle political and adaptive challenges of the UHC agenda.

The **Leadership for Universal Health Coverage Program (L4UHC)** is jointly designed and implemented by GIZ and the World Bank Group (WBG) and a contribution to the Providing for Health (P4H) global network UHC and Social Health Protection (SHP)

Successful implementation of UHC reform requires individuals, groups, and organizations to effectively work together toward achieving complex objectives and staying focused on results. This process usually requires taking into account multiple perspectives as well as accepting and adopting new ways of doing things. Simply put, this is part of “How to do UHC reforms”, ranging from project level initiatives to large scale policy change.

The Leadership program is a 11-month journey including three modules. The first module will be hosted in the Philippines, taking place in Manila May 17 to 20 2016.

During this period of time with three face-to-face events and in-country support, the Program will support participants in personal transformation and acquiring leadership skills needed to navigate the complexities of the UHC process. Participants in their country teams will be widening their impact by in-country work with results-oriented implementation and coalition building support. They will be developing a strong peer community of reformers during the one-year engagement in the Program and beyond.
